Hello All,

Jill posted the following question in the Mayor's corner:

Thank-you for making this site available for asking questions. I have lived here in Jamestown for six years and it is just a lovely town. I am glad that I found this gem. I have noticed that lovely new street signs and stop signs have been placed around town and have begun coming down Oakdale Rd. I live down the street further in the Jamestown Oaks development. Are the new street signs going to continue on down the street and into my development?

We are very proud of our sign post replacement program, and we are glad that residents and visitors are as well. Town staff will continue to replace sign posts down Oakdale Road this year. This year's sign program will include replacing the five small entrance signs at Oakdale Road , Harvey Road, Dillon Road, W. Main Street, Penny Road , and on East Fork Road . We anticipate replacing street name and stop signs along Oakdale Road at the intersections of Chimney Court , Oak Village Drive , Oakdale Mill Road , and Jamestown Oaks Drive. The balance of the sign post budget will be spent on a replacing regulatory signs beginning near the railroad tracks on Oakdale Drive and heading south toward Harvey Rd. Should the budget not allow for all sign posts to be replaced along Oakdale Rd. this year, we will again ask for funding to complete post replacement next fiscal year (beginning July 1, 2012)

We are hopeful funding will be restored to begin replacing posts along Dillon Rd. and Penny Rd. Once these roadway sign posts are replaced, all major roads in Jamestown will then have the new black fluted sign post. Our goal will be then to focus on replacing posts within neighborhoods beginning with the oldest first.

Unfortunately, because of a slow economy our budget does not allow us to move as fast as we would like.
