Dear Jamestown Citizen,

The Town of Jamestown has contracted with Breece Enterprises, Inc of High Point, North Carolina to construct a new 6" water main in Guilford Rd. The contract was awarded by Town Council at the April 20th Council Meeting. The water main in Guilford Rd. will be constructed from just south of the Hamlin Ct. intersection to just north of the O'Neill Dr. intersection.

Why are the water pipes being replaced?

These water mains were selected to be replaced due to the age of the pipe, pipe material and maintenance performed through the years.

How long will it take to construct the water mains?

The contractor has sixty days (60) from about May 1 to July 1, 2010 to substantially complete the project. The clock is ticking and the contractor will begin work soon.

Will I experience any interruptions in my current water service during construction? Should I expect any temporary service loss or loss of water quality?

A temporary loss in service may occur while we work near your property and would last for only a short duration. There may be some cloudiness or discoloration in the water when turned back on. Residents will be contacted via written notices or in person when service to their home may be interrupted.

Will I be able to travel the roads?

Yes, Guilford Rd will remain open to through traffic. The contractor will provide access to your property or notify you if access to your property will be temporarily unavailable.

Construction equipment, such as an excavator, backhoe, and dump trucks, will travel the road frequently. Please take extreme care when walking or driving these roads. You may experience open trenches, dust, rock and soil on the road, and the above mentioned equipment. This equipment will be parked on the side roads (Hamlin Ct., Mamie Ln., Cloverbrook Dr., Wyndwood Dr., and O'Neill Dr.) throughout the entire project.

What You Can Do To Help

The most important way you can help is to keep yourself and the construction workers safe. Follow the orange construction signs and watch for workers. Also, please do not park on the side roads near Guilford Rd.
